



## Ukrainian Technological Society Scholarship Application for High School Students Graduating in 2024

### Eligibility

The UTS offers scholarships to students of Ukrainian ancestry who has permanent residence in Western Pennsylvania, the Austintown-Youngstown areas, and the northern panhandle of West Virginia, seeking or continuing a post-High School education (community college, college, trade school, nursing, business school, law school, medical school). Detailed eligibility requirements can be found on the scholarship application form.

**Application** - A new, completed application is necessary for each year. The application consists of both the completed UTS Scholarship Application Form and your official academic transcript issued by your school's registrar showing all courses taken and grades received. Please contact your registrar as soon as possible to secure your official transcript. Unofficial transcripts downloaded from websites, etc. are NOT acceptable. Entering first year of a post-High School education students must submit their completed high school transcript. Please complete all sections of the Application Form; incomplete Application Forms will NOT be considered. Official school transcripts are to be sent to: UTS Scholarship Committee, P.O.
